Educated at Tottenham Grammar School, then University College, Southampton, subsequently the University of Southampton: Ph.D Southampton on Rousseau's *Émile*. After some years as a schoolteacher, joined French Department of Birmingham University in 1958, then moved to a Chair in French at the University of Stirling in 1972. Since retirement in 1993, Emeritus Professor in University of Stirling, and currently Professorial Research Fellow in University of Glasgow.

Professor Jimack has published books and articles on various aspects of 18th Century literature and thought, chiefly on Rousseau, Diderot and Raynal, and he is currently collaborating in the publication of a critical edition of Raynal's *Histoire de deux Indes*, the first volume of which appeared in 2010.
